At a very young age, Shantih played drums until learning to play piano at the age of 17. In realizing that the quality of her home demos where stirring attention on campus, she began to peruse a more professional approach. She then reached out to many of the top studios in Los Angeles, booking studio tours and networking with their staff of engineers. To her surprise the engineers loved to talk shop, disclosing the current tips and tricks of the trade. In building relationships with these engineers, they began calling her to sit in on big budget film scoring sessions. Her professional audio career started when she moved to Topanga California and worked for five years as an assistant engineer in a high-end recording studio, Skyline Recording. During this time, she worked with many top name engineers and producers.

Shantih then went back to school for 6 years studying film scoring and orchestral writing at Cal State Northridge. After graduating, she was offered a job to work with David Benoit at his 29th Street Studio in Torrance, California as a staff engineer. She excelled to head engineer and eventually studio manager until the sale of the studio 4 years later. While there, she worked with countless artist and producers, building a substantial clientele.

Now having great equipment and clientele to work with, She decided to design and build her own studio. Studio 770 was opened on Sept 13th 2000. The studio has been producing music for over 16 years. She has clients that have been working with her for over 20 years.

Shantih's passion is to share her experience of sitting in on recording sessions and witnessing the process of capturing the highest form of sound quality. "The sound itself can take you to an elevated state." Her mission is to bring that high quality sound to other musicians, giving artists a sonic texture that enhances their music. In the past few years, many music artists seem to have lost interest in high quality recordings.
